- ❑ Enables the child to understand significant events in the past.
- ❑ Confront feelings that are secondary to these events.
- ❑ Become more fully involved in the future planning of their lives.

DIRECT WORK WITH CHILDREN IS USED FOR:

- ❑ Gaining an understanding of the child's perceptions of his life
- ❑ Disengagement work
- ❑ Explaining plans for the future
- ❑ Addressing current areas of concern enhancing attachments in current family
- ❑ Facilitating identity formation
- ❑ Increasing the child's knowledge of self
- ❑ Reintegration of early life events
- ❑ Focusing on life-long issues
