

Community Resources

PROBATION

Role of Program:

- Provide services to the community, the victim, and the juvenile offender.
- Restore justice through accountability, restoration of losses, community protection, and the preservation of the family.

Typical Services Offered:

- Contact for juveniles who are caught and/or charged in a criminal act.
- Support for juveniles involved in the legal system and their families.
- Placement of juveniles if needed, upon entering the juvenile justice system.

SCHOOL SYSTEM

Role of School System:

- Provide a solid education for each child or adolescent in their system. This includes academics, social/emotional growth and safety.

Typical Services Offered:

- academics
- special education services
- psychologist when academics are impacted
- school-wide testing
- speech, vision, hearing and other support services

MEDICAL COMMUNITY

Role of Program:

- Treat general physical conditions of children and adolescents, in addition to any special needs that may arise.

Typical Services Offered:

- general medical expertise
- specialized medical expertise
- referrals to specialized medical help when needed

MENTAL HEALTH COMMUNITY

Role of System:

- Provide services to the individuals struggling with mental health issues and their families by identifying mental health issues and to offer support through both in-home and out-of-home services.

Typical Services Offered:

- behavioral therapy
- psychotherapy
- play therapy
- art therapy
- family therapy
- psychological evaluation
- psychiatric evaluation

DRUG AND ALCOHOL SYSTEM

Role of Drug and Alcohol System:

- Teach individuals with drug and alcohol problems how to live substance-free through support, education, and accountability.
- Refer to support programs and counseling.

Typical Services Offered:

- drug and alcohol evaluations
- counseling to individuals and their families
- education
- referral source for follow-up support
- support groups
