

Competencies

309-1: The Child Welfare Professional can recognize indicators of alcohol abuse in adults and children; understands typical dynamics of alcoholic families; knows how an alcoholic parent can affect a child's development and behavior; knows the relationship between alcohol abuse and family violence; and can refer to appropriate treatment resources.

309-2: The Worker can recognize the indicators of drug abuse, such as cocaine addiction, in adults and children; understands the potential effects of drug use on family functioning; and knows appropriate referral methods and treatment resources.
