

Visitation Planning Form - Completed

Case Goals:

1. Katie to return home with her mother and be safe at home.

Dates for Which the Plan is Effective:

1. From first week of placement through end of third month (total of 12 weeks)

People to be Included in the Visits:

1. Katie and Jennifer (mother)
2. Katie and Gloria Parker (grandmother)

Visit Frequency:

1. Twice per week
2. Once per week as Mrs. Parker's health allows

Other Contact:

1. Jennifer will call on Monday and Thursday nights at 6:30 p.m. and talk for 10 minutes.
2. Grandmom Gloria will call on Saturdays and/or Sundays as schedules permit.
3. Katie may send letters, cards, and drawings to her Mother and Grandmom as desired.

Visit Location:

1. At the Visitation Center or, later on, supervised at the home of the Maternal Grandmother.

Visit Length and Time of Visits:

1. Begin with two-hour visits on Tuesdays and Saturdays from 2:00 – 4:00. This will be evaluated after two weeks, or sooner, if Jennifer is able to obtain employment. If she does obtain employment, the schedule may need to be changed. Visitation may increase or become less restrictively supervised as a result of evaluation.
2. Grandmom Gloria will visit Katie on Saturdays along with Jennifer

Visit Supervision:

1. By Case Aide

Visit Purpose (list specific objectives that pertain to permanency plan goal):

1. To encourage Jennifer to practice positive discipline with Katie.
2. To increase in a positive way the bond between Jennifer and Katie
3. To keep the positive bond between Gloria and Katie in tact
4. To assure Katie that her mother has not abandoned her

Transportation Arrangements:

1. The Fitzgeralds will bring Katie to the Visitation Center and pick her up.
2. Jennifer and Gloria will find transportation (e.g., take the bus or get a ride with a friend.)
Bus tokens will be provided by CYS.

Visit Activities (that will support permanency plan goal):

1. Jennifer will practice tuning into Katie's needs and meeting them. She will use the help of the case aide as needed. This might involve holding and rocking Katie, preparing her a snack with food supplied by the Visitation Center, reading together, and playing games.
2. Gloria will provide emotional support to Katie and Jennifer.

Visit Conditions:

1. Jennifer will use suggestions made by the case aide during the visits.
2. Jennifer will not tell Katie about any of her problems, nor make inappropriate promises to her.
3. Jennifer will be sober during all visits.
4. Jennifer will come to the visit on time.

Agency Services to Support Visitation:

1. Bus tokens for Jennifer and Grandma Gloria.
2. Supervision of the visit, including suggestions for Jennifer in meeting Katie's needs.
