### Circumstances and Concerns During The Review Period:

1. Ms. Parker did not attend parenting classes.
2. Ms. Parker was arrested and jailed for prostitution, possession of drugs, and violating her parole.
3. Ms. Parker was intoxicated when she was arrested.
4. Mr. Johnson volunteered to terminate his parental rights.
5. Ms. Parker admitted that she cannot provide full-time care for Katie.
