11 Month Update

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Jennifer stopped attending her drug treatment program and was again incarcerated; this time for drug possession. She does not know how long she will need to stay in prison. She says she wants Katie to be able to visit her there.

Katie continued to visit with her grandmother who is now separated from Mr. Smith. Mrs. Parker reports he moved to Florida to be closer to his own grandchildren.

Mr. Johnson, Katie's father, has not had any contact with the agency for several months.

The Fitzgerald's continue to state that, if needed, they can be a permanent resource for Katie.

A Permanency Hearing is scheduled for 1 month from now; do you recommend Katie's goal be changed? If so, what goal are you recommending?

On what factors is your recommendation based ?
