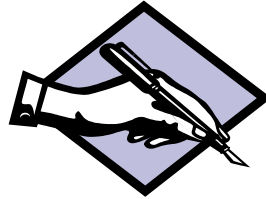
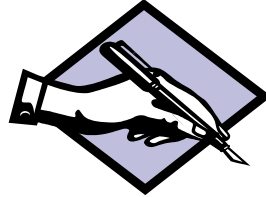


Instructions for Identifying the Stages in the Casework Process



1. Each group reads their assigned case vignette(s).
2. With your learning partners, identify the correct stage in the casework process.
3. When your group has agreed on a stage, using a marker, print the number of the case on a post-it note and put it on the appropriate block on the navigational guide posted on the wall.
4. On a piece of paper, identify which of the mission-critical outcomes (safety, permanency, and well-being) and item number is being addressed in the vignette.

5. When your stage is discussed, the presenter will tell/ask the class:

- The stage of the casework process
- What indicators/information helped your group to identify this stage?
- The mission-critical outcomes and item numbers that may be addressed in the case at this stage of the process.
- How many of you in your group, work with cases that are in this stage?
- How many in the whole class work with cases in this stage?
