

COMPETENCIES:

- 106-1: The child welfare professional knows the personal, interpersonal, family, and environmental factors which increase risk.
- 106-2: The child welfare professional knows investigation and interviewing strategies to assess and determine the degree of risk to a child.

COMPETENCIES: (continued)

106-4: The Child Welfare Professional is able to gather pertinent information and can make an initial assessment of risk and appropriate case disposition.
