

204: Introduction to the Safety Assessment and Management Process: A Brief Overview

Effective safety assessment and management controls threats of serious harm to a child throughout the entire casework process and links to risk assessment and family service plan activities. Assessing and analyzing safety threats and protective capacities serves as the foundation for safety decision making, planning, and managing. Safety assessment and management has an effect on not only safety outcomes, but also permanency and well-being outcomes. This training on safety assessment introduces knowledge and skills necessary for performing safety assessment and management in compliance with the federal statute and state law and regulation as well as best practice.
