Did you know that the Victims Compensation Assistance Program (VCAP) paid over \$13 million dollars to over 7,000 crime victims last year! VCAP reimburses victims for expense resulting from crime, such as medical bills, funeral expenses, loss of support, counseling, loss of earnings, stolen cash benefits, relocation, attorney fees and crime-scene cleanup. This session will provide you with a basic overview of the Program (including eligibility criteria and available expenses) and all the forms and information you need to assist someone filing a claim. This session is for individuals with no prior knowledge of VCAP, although those with some knowledge will certainly benefit as well.
